Lolite Blue

Lolite is known since the time of vikings, with it's attractive deep-blue to violet colours. Stones similar to lolite include blue sapphires and Tanzanite. lolite rates 7.5 in hardness.



Amethyst

Amethyst is the violet purple variety of quartz. It is found in a wide range of shades of purple. It rates 7 in hardness.



Peridot

Peridot is the gem-quality variety of "Olivine" and has been used as a gem stone for 3500 years. It comes in shades of green. It rates 7 in hardness.



Pink Sapphire

Pink sapphires are one of the most highly regarded and valuable of the fancy coloured sapphires. Pink sapphire rates 9 in hardness.
